

# Equity in Athletics Report Western Nebraska Community College Men's and Women's Intercollegiate Athletics 2022-23 Academic Year

The Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA) was designed to make prospective students and prospective student-athletes aware of an institution of higher education's commitment to providing equitable athletic opportunities for its students. The EADA requires the disclosure of information about varsity teams and the financial resources and personnel that the school dedicates to those teams.

Any co-educational institution of higher education that participates ina federal student aid program must prepare an EADA report by October 15 of each year. Institutions must also report data to the U.S. Department of Education via an online survey. This is a mandatory report.

Data collected in this survey is published by the Office of Postsecondary Education on the Equity in Athletics Data Analysis web site located at *ope.ed.gov/athletics/#/*. In addition, the data collected in this survey is provided by institutions in accordance with the EADA and may not be the same data used for determining compliance with other federal or state laws, including Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972.

## **Total Expenses and Revenues**

**Total Expenses** are all expenses attributable to intercollegiate athletic activities. This includes appearance guarantees and options, athletically related student aid, contract services, equipment, fundraising activities, operating expenses, promotional activities, recruiting expenses, salaries and benefits, supplies, travel, and any other expenses attributable to intercollegiate athletic activities.

**Total Revenues** are revenues attributable to intercollegiate athletic activities. This includes revenues from appearance guarantees and options, an athletic conference, tournament or bowl games, concessions, contributions from alumni and others, institutional support, program advertising and sales, radio and television, royalties, signage and other sponsorships, sports campus, state or other government support, student activity fees, ticket and luxury box sales, and any other revenues attributable to intercollegiate athletic activities.
