The Board of Governors is pleased to announce that it has begun the search for the next president of Western Nebraska Community College. This appointment will shape WNCC's future for years to come and the Board is committed to conducting an equitable, inclusive, and transparent national search that will attract a strong pool of candidates from throughout the nation. The Board has selected the Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) to assist us with the presidential search process. ACCT's assistance will include providing support with the development of the presidential profile, recruiting highly competitive candidates and working with the Board of Governors and the Screening and Interview Committee. ACCT has conducted over 500 community college searches and brings a wealth of knowledge and expertise to our process. ACCT's mission is to strengthen community college governance through education and advocacy. Dr. Pam Fisher will serve as our ACCT Search Consultant and be on campus to work with the Board and the Screening and Interview Committee.

## **Presidential Profile Development**

An important step in the presidential search process is the development of a Presidential Profile. One part of that development is hosting an open forum for all interested persons. The purpose of the forum is to share information about the process and gather your input on key issues. The entire College community is invited and encouraged to participate in a discussion about the qualities, characteristics, and qualifications we are seeking in our next president, and the opportunities and challenges facing Western Nebraska Community College in the next three to five years. Dr. Fisher will facilitate the forum session; it will be held on **June 19 from 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.** in The Plex at the John N. Harms Center. You are welcome to come for only a part of the forum if you have a schedule conflict.

## The Screening and Interview Committee

## **Updates and Information on the Search Process**

Finalists will be on campus for open forums in early November when the entire College community will have an opportunity to meet them. The goal is for a decision to be made by late November and our new President to join us the first of January.

When the position profile is complete and approved, there will be a webpage on the WNCC website that includes information on all aspects of the search, both for the College community and candidates. We will post information pertaining to the search, including regular progress reports, on that website as the search progresses.
