Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA)

What is the Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act?

The Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act is designed to make prospective students aware of a school's commitment to providing equitable athletic opportunities for its men and women students. Any co-educational institution of higher education that participates in any title IV, HEA program; and has an intercollegiate athletic program must provide information concerning its intercollegiate athletics programs in compliance with the U.S. Department of Education requirements to ensure parity in athletic programming. This act and accompanying Federal regulations require the information be available to students, prospective students and the public by October 15 each year. Institutions must also report data to the U.S. Department of Education via the online mandatory survey. The Department uses this information in preparing its required report to the Congress on gender equity in intercollegiate athletics.

What kind of information must schools make available?

Schools must provide information on:

- Sports teams and participation by gender;
- Athletic scholarship dollars awarded to female and male athletes;
- Average salaries of head and assistant coaches for women's and men's teams;
- Number of head and assistant coaches for women's and men's teams;
- Recruitment expenses for female and male athletes;
- Revenues for women's and men's teams;
- Operating expenses for women's and men's team;
- Overall expenses for woman's and men's teams.
