

### **Executive Summary**

#### AS OF THE TENTH DAY OF THE SEMESTER (SEPTEMBER 02, 2022):

- 1. THERE ARE **680 FULL-TIME** AND **1,230 PART-TIME** STUDENTS. THE TOTAL ENROLLMENT OF **1,910 REPRESENTS A 11.9% INCREASE** COMPARED TO FALL 2021 (FALL 2021 10-DAY ENROLLMENT = 1,706).
- 2. FEMALE TO MALE RATIO IS 66.87% FEMALE TO 33.13% MALE OVERALL.
- 3. **HISPANIC ENROLLMENT IS 473 REPRESENTING 24.8% OF ALL STUDENTS.** THIS STUDENT POPULATION IS THE 2ND LARGEST ETHNIC GROUP BEHIND ONLY WHITE NON-HISPANIC STUDENTS.
- 4. NATIVE AMERICAN ENROLLMENT IS 70 REPRESENTING 3.7% OF ALL STUDENTS. THIS STUDENT POPULATION IS THE 2ND LARGEST RACIAL GROUP BEHIND ONLY WHITE STUDENTS.
- 5. TOTAL FTE IS 552.06 REPRESENTING A 4.16% DECREASE OVER FALL 2021.
- 6. THE WNCC STUDENT BODY HAS STUDENTS **REPRESENTING EACH OF THE COUNTIES**WITHIN THE WCCA SERVICE AREA.
- 7. HIGH SCHOOL DUAL ENROLLMENT REPRESENTS A 30.90% OF WNCC'S TOTAL ENROLLMENT (590 TOTAL DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENTS).







### WESTERN NEBRASKA COMMUNITY COLLEGE Enrollment Percent Native American - Four-year Comparison






