10-DAY ENROLLMENT REPORT FALL 2020



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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1. As of the tenth day of the semester, there were 711 full-time and 914 part-time students. This is a collective decrease of 5.6 percent from last year which could be considered a creditable outcome given the potential impact of the pandemic. The expected end-of-semester count should reach 721 full-time and 954 part-time students.
- 2. The aggregate number of re-admitted students, continuing students, and transfer students (both full- and part-time) shows an increase of 33 students over the same group last year. Unfortunately, the first-time student number shows a decline despite the dedicated efforts of the Admissions and Advising staff.
- 3. The male to female ratio and the age distribution of WNCC students remain largely unchanged over the past several years. Of our total students, 62.6 percent are female and 37.4 percent are male. Among age ranges, the highest percentage is 46.9 percent for those 18 to 24 years of age.
- 4. HISPANIC ENROLLMENT IS NOW AT A RECORD 28.2 PERCENT OF THE FULL-TIME STUDENT BODY AND 27.2% OVERALL. DUE TO COVID-19 PREVENTING MANY INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS FROM ATTENDING, OUR FULL-TIME INTERNATIONAL NUMBER DROPPED FROM 65 TO 39. WE DID PICK UP 11 STUDENTS ATTENDING PART-TIME IN THEIR HOME COUNTRY.
- 5. THE FALL 2020 END-OF-SEMESTER FTE IS PROJECTED TO REACH CLOSE TO 600, BUT THERE IS NOT MUCH CONFIDENCE IN PROJECTING NON-CREDIT REIMBURSABLE FTE DUE TO THE PANDEMIC AND THE DECLINE IN CORPORATE TRAINING.
- 6. From the 24 high schools in the WNCC service area, the College attracted 14.1 percent of the 2020 senior class which is not as high as in recent years. There is a tendency for recurring waves in the student yield particularly from the larger high schools. For example, Gering high school showed a record yield in 2019 (53), but is much lower this year (30). It will likely rebound next year.
- 7. This year we have full-time students representing every county in the service area which has not always been the case. Nebraska students outside of the service area increased by 8 while out-of-state students increased by 25 over last year.
- 8. PROGRAMS WHICH HAVE GROWN OVER THE LAST YEAR INCLUDE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (64 STUDENTS NOW COMPARED TO 50 LAST YEAR), AND THE FOLLOWING: EXERCISE SCIENCE (25 NOW/ 5 LAST YEAR), ASSOCIATE OF FINE ARTS (28/10), POWERLINE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE (28/20), MEDICAL LAB TECHNOLOGY (11/3), AND PRE-DENTAL HYGIENE (27/18).






