

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1. As of the tenth day of the semester, there were 765 full-time and 1060 part-time students (collectively a 4.2 percent decrease from last year). The expected end-of-semester count should reach 790 full-time and 1170 part-time students.
- 2. The number of first-time, full-time students increased from 273 to 319 (a 16.8 percent increase) which is a rebound from the drop that occurred last year. The numbers of full-time and part-time continuing students has fallen in recent years as a reflection of the inability to attract increasing numbers of new students. Hopefully, this trend can be reversed starting with the positive showing of first-time students this fall.
- 3. The male/female distribution and average age of WNCC students remain steady. The percent of students under age 18 (primarily 17-year olds) has increased from 16.5 percent five years ago to 31 percent of total enrollment today due to our increase in College Now students.
- 4. The percent of full-time students who are Hispanic is up slightly, now at 24.5 percent. There are 78 international students this fall representing 32 countries. Less than half of these students are here for athletics.
- 5. The end-of-semester projection for full-time equivalent students (FTE) is 820.5, a slight increase. This number is becoming increasingly difficult to project, particularly the non-credit component of FTE.
- 6. From the 24 high schools in the in the WNCC service area, the College attracted 15.7 percent of the 2018 senior class, a slight increase from last year's 14.7 percent. There was an increase of 40 out-of-state high school graduates coming this fall (from 52 to 92).

- 7. All counties in the WNCC service area are represented in the fall enrollment except for Sioux County. As there were only three high school seniors to draw from at Sioux County High School last year, this is not surprising. What is surprising is 13 are represented from Cherry County, a strong showing in comparison to past years.
- 8. Among degree-seeking students, 62 percent are in academic transfer programs and 38 percent in technical training programs. One hundred thirteen students have indicated the ADN program as their major and 69 have indicated the Practical Nursing program. There are 43 ADN and 40 PN students accepted this fall which shows the disparity between the interest level and the number we can take in. Those choosing General Studies as their major continue to represent a declining percentage of the total in comparison to previous years.






