## DO SOME RESEARCH

- Find out what colleges offer the programs in which you are interested:

    - **TIDBIT:** Interested in looking at other states? A simple Google search on "higher education in [insert state]" will get you the information you need.
- Find out what scholarship opportunities are available and learn about the deadlines for submission.
- Research the admission processes for the colleges and programs in which you are interested.
- Research the communities in which the colleges are located (think about size, things to do, cost of living, etc.).

- Learning about the process for requesting and sending transcripts.

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## I KNOW WHERE I'M HEADED, NOW WHAT?

- ✓ Plan a visit to the college or university you have selected to make sure it is right for you.
- ✓ Apply for admission.
- ✓ Apply for scholarships and financial aid.
  - **TIDBIT:** Remember that you can start the FAFSA submission process on December. It's the same no matter what college or university you attend!
- ✓ Request that your WNCB (and any other) transcripts be sent and evaluated.
- ✓ Make direct contact with the department that houses the program you will be studying (e.g. Education, Criminal Justice, Business, etc.).
- ✓ Plan to attend transfer orientation if it is available!
