

## **Paramedic Program Admission Steps**

Applications for the hybrid paramedic program beginning Fall 2025 can be submitted between **June 1, 2025 and June 30, 2025**. Selection for admission is a competitive process and will be based on entrance exam scores and interview with program director.

#### Program admission requirements include:

- Apply and be accepted as student at WNCC
- Current National Registry or Nebraska EMT licensure in active standing.
- Current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) card from state board approved agency valid throughout the entirety of the program
- Completion of Platinum Education EMT-P Math Assessment
- Completion of Platinum Education Paramedic Entry Assessment (EMT Level)

#### **Requirements to be completed following provisional acceptance include:**

- Current immunizations (see required vaccinations page)
- Recent negative TB test (see TB information page)
- Negative drug test
- Proof of recent physical examination completed by physician, PA or NP
- Students provisionally accepted into the program are required to undergo a Castlebranch criminal background check as part of the admissions process
- Full admission to the program is contingent upon completion of the background check, immunization record, physical examination requirements, entrance exam scores and interview with program director.

## **Paramedic Program Admission Steps**

Following review of application and entrance exams scores, you will be contacted by the program to set up an interview. After the interview you will be notified of a provisional acceptance or denial. Once a provisional acceptance has been issued, you will receive more information on completion of steps 7-11. Official acceptance into the program will be awarded after completion of steps 7-11.
