Swanson Scholarship Application for Western Nebraska Community College transfer students to a four-year college

The Swanson transfer scholarship assists academically promising students pursuing a baccalaureate degree in Elementary Education. The scholarship provides \$1,000 in financial assistance with tuition for transfers from Western Nebraska Community College. The scholarship is awarded for one academic year (\$500 each of two semesters). Recipients of this scholarship must enroll as full-time students carrying 12 hours or more per semester. Recipients may apply in subsequent years.

The following information is required in order to apply for the Swanson Scholarship. The completed application, along with transcripts and a letter of recommendation, should be sent to: Western Nebraska Community College, Office of Financial Aid, 1601 E. 27th Street, Scottsbluff, Nebraska 69361. To be eligible for the Swanson Scholarship, an applicant must meet the follo	wing qualifications:
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- Be a transfer student from Western Nebraska Community College and enrolled or planning to enroll as a full-time undergraduate student in an Elementary Education Program at a four-year Nebraska institution.
- Received an Associates degree from Western Nebraska Community College with a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- 3. Must complete an application form for a Nebraska four-year institution.
- 4. Include the attached reference form.
- 5. Transcripts are required.

Other factors may be considered as appropriate, such as honors, activities and evidence of leadership.
